



## Hīkoi ki Waitangi: Karuwā 2019

Sunday 3 Feb – Wednesday 6 Feb 2019

### Service at Te Tii Marae

We'll be helping with service at Te Tii Marae throughout the hīkoi. Service blocks are approximately 3hrs. You will have been allocated a service slot and will be told your times at the mihi whakatau. If you can not make your pre-allocated slot please arrange to swap with someone else and let the Karuwā team know.

During this hīkoi we will have a large Karuwā marquee (at Te Tii Marae, 30 Te Karuwā Parade) as a base of sorts - you will be welcome to hang out and connect with others in it, escape the weather, rest after your service and gather for korero.

### Sunday Day 1 3rd Feb

- 10:30am Karuwā Mihi Whakatau/Welcome at Rangihoua Heritage Park, Oihi Road, Te Tii (1 hr drive from Paihia, 3 ½ hrs from Auckland).
- Visit Oihi Bay and Marsden Cross with Kaumātua Te Hurihanga Rihani. *This involves a walk and optional swim - wear walking shoes and bring towel/togs and water bottle. BYO picnic style lunch at the Bay.*
- 2pm Leave for Waitangi, park near Te Karuwā Parade.
- 4pm Powhiri - Te Tii Marae, we will be welcomed on as a group by the hau kainga. *Wahine please wear a skirt and tane wear pants.*

### Monday Day 2 4th Feb

- Breakfast Suggestion: 8:30am Alfresco's Restaurant, 6 Marsden Road, Paihia.

Or 10:30am Explore the Treaty Grounds and Waitangi Museum on an official private tour. Meet at the entrance of the Treaty Grounds 15 min prior to tour (this needs to be pre-booked with us). Costs \$20.00

- 9:00pm           Early night in prep for ultra early wake up.



**Wednesday            Waitangi Day Day 4**

5:00am            Dawn Prayer Service at Whare Runanga, Treaty Grounds (this starts promptly so ensure you get up early and wear something warm).

Suggestion: Breakfast provided by MPs at Upper Treaty Grounds.

Morning            Enjoy the Waitangi Day Festival. An official Waitangi Day Festival schedule will be available on the day and will include waka launching, kapa haka, music, 21 gun salute and naval parade.

10:00am            Interdenominational Church Service at Whare Runanga, Treaty  
Grounds

Afternoon            Waitangi Day festivities continue

2:00pm            Hakari (meal) with the Hau Kainga, Te Tii Marae  
- this will include our farewells to each other and our hosts.

4:30pm            Safe journeys home (or relaxed night for those staying this evening).

Evening            Ngawha Hot Springs, soak and debrief,  
Ngawha springs road (30 mins from Paihia). close at 9:00pm.  
*These are natural thermal hot springs - wear dark/old togs, costs \$4.*
